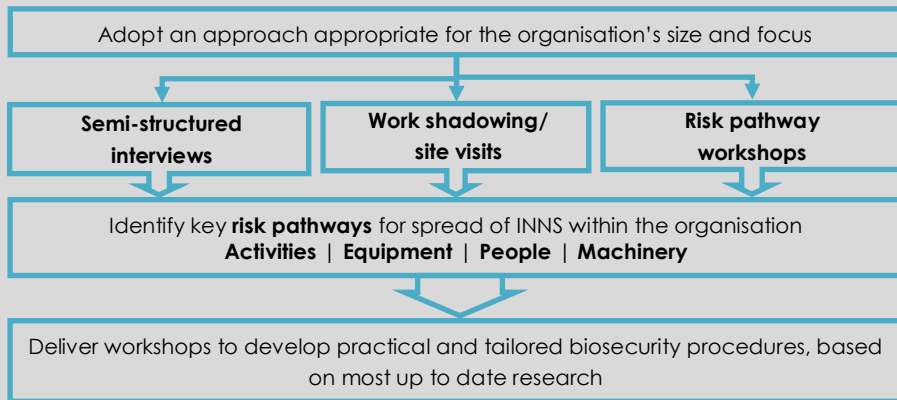
### Prioritisation of **Aim 1** :
