- 1. What is the source of a river? It is where a river starts, on high ground in the hills, and may be a spring, a lake, marshy or boggy ground.
- 2. Where is the source of the River Swale? At the confluence of Birkdale and Great Sleddale Becks.
- 3. The first section of a river is called the Upper Course. What are the other two sections called? Middle Course and Lower Course.
- 4. In what part of the river course are waterfalls usually found? The Upper Course.
- 5. Name two types of valley. Which type is formed by rivers? U-shaped and V-shaped, the V-shaped is formed by Rivers (the U-shaped by glaciers).
- 6. In which valley is Aysgarth Falls found? Wensleydale.
- 7. Name 3 species of birds which you might find near a river: Kingfisher, Grey Heron, Mallard, Dipper, Grey Wagtail and Sandpiper, Sand Martin, Goosander.
- 8. Name 3 sorts of river invertebrates found in a healthy river: Mayfly nymphs, cased caddisfly larvae, stonefly nymphs, freshwater shrimp, freshwater crayfish, damselfly nymphs.
- 9. What is a meander? A natural bend in a river.
- 10. Rivers constantly move and change shape. What two processes cause this to happen? Erosion and deposition.
- 11. Which river flows through the town of Ilkley? The River Wharfe
- 12. What is a floodplain? The area by the side of the river where the river naturally floods.
- 13. What is the main river which flows through York? The River Ouse.
- 14. What is the name of the sea that all rivers from the Yorkshire Dales eventually flow in to? The North Sea.
